### **Guidelines for Camp Out For Cancer (please share with your group)**

**MOST IMPORTANT RULE:** Respect one another and respect the fairgrounds!

- Stay within the yellow ribbon boundaries.
- No posting, taping, stapling anything to any of the buildings or fences, please.
- **DO NOT CLIMB ON RAILINGS OR BUILDINGS.**
- Clean up the fairgrounds before you leave.

### **PARKING & VEHICLE INFO**

- General parking is located directly off Main St. (elementary school field). From Jackson, Take Hwy 49 into Plymouth, go past Sierra Trading Post and turn left onto Main St. Follow Main St. past the stop sign and shortly after you will see the parking entrance on your left. At night the entrance will be lit.
- Parking is free, however there will be a team asking for donations at the parking lot. All funds raised go to the cause!
- If you need assistance getting to your campsite from the main gate, let the volunteers know and they can arrange to have a golf cart come and pick you up.
- You will not be allowed to drive onto the fairgrounds on Saturday -- foot traffic only.

## GENERAL INFO & REMINDERS

- **Tobacco and alcohol free event**, in keeping with a healthy lifestyle and for a family-friendly atmosphere.
- **Leave your pets at home** to relax. *Pets are not allowed at the event.*
- Bring sunscreen. (Sunscreen also available at registration)
- Bring a change of clothes. Nights cool off so bring layers, sweatshirts and jackets.
- Lost and Found located at Registration.
- Credit card sales (Visa and Mastercard) at Registration (minimum \$20 purchase). If short on cash, use your credit card to obtain cash.
- No barbecues, campfires or fire pits allowed. (Teams who obtained permission to barbecue in advance need to keep the barbecue secure, so nobody gets burned.)
- **CELL PHONES: off from 7 p.m. - 7 a.m.** Respect this rule. Don't share your conversations; show respect to those attending the event.
- **NO RUNNING OR JOGGING ON THE ROUTE.**
- The meal schedule on the program is a guideline only. The meal times for those with wristbands will be posted at the food area, and are subject to change. Snack bar open through midnight! Tri-tip sandwiches and walking tacos also for sale. Team captains will have the programs for you to view at the event..
- Raley's is again donating water for registered participants. **PLEASE DO NOT HORSEPLAY OR WASTE BOTTLED WATER.**
- **DO NOT** to take down any tents, shade tents or campsites until after the conclusion of the event at 9 a.m. on Sunday. No vehicles allowed onto fairgrounds until 9:30 a.m. Do not park and block any roads. Only bring vehicle onto fairgrounds when you are ready to load and pull out.

**If you notice something that needs attention, please let a volunteer in a yellow shirt know.**

**Remember, we are giving up a weekend for those touched by cancer, so it might be noisy and you might not get any sleep, but it is just one weekend -- in honor of those who live with cancer 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.**
