The event is sponsored by the Amador STARS (Support, Transportation and Resource Services) and its purpose is to raise awareness of cancer, to support cancer survivors and celebrate life, and to raise funds to assist local cancer patients and their families.

The Amador County Camp Out for Cancer will take place on Sept. 10th at the Amador County Fairgrounds in Plymouth. For 22 hours, teams will camp out and take turns hiking around the grounds while enjoying friendship, good food and listening to local artists perform. It is a family event and all ages attend. There will be games, dunk tank, volleyball and other activities. At 10:00 am we will have our Survivor Ceremony, followed by the opening ceremony at noon. At 7:30 pm, we will hold a candlelight illumination ceremony. The candles will light the way for our nighttime hikers.

They give free wigs and offer advice on beauty techniques to combat the appearance-related side effects of cancer treatment. They also donate to research.
